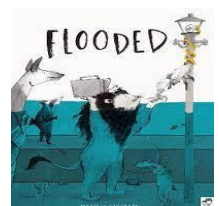

Around the Classrooms:

Donladson: This week, in Maths, we have been looking at doubles within 10 in Reception and subtraction and subtraction patterns in Year 1. In English, we have all re-written the story of Handa's Surprise and used the pictures in the book to explore different countries as part of our Geography project, 'Where will the Magic carpet take us?' We have also enjoyed exploring our World Book Day text, 'Flooded'.

Dahl: This week, we have been exploring measuring mass in grams in Maths and in English we have all created our own poem inspired by the poem 'I am a Roman Soldier'. In History, we explored the question 'What did the Roman's leave behind?' looking at central heating, roads, concrete etc. We also enjoyed exploring our World Book Day text 'Flooded' creating a short diary entry.

Rowling: This week, we have been mastering co-ordinates, position and direction, and translation in Maths. In English and Geography, we have been researching a European country to create a fact file as part of our project '80 days around the World'. In Science, we have been examining what happens to the human body when humans get old. We have also enjoyed exploring our World Book Day text 'Flooded'.



Pre-School:

We have had a great week in Pre-school celebrating world book day. The children have enjoyed bringing in books from home to share and some have enjoyed dressing up as favourite characters from books. We have been thinking about 'Maths in Space' and have started our final super six book of the term, 'Aliens Love Underpants' by Claire Freedman and Ben Cort. There has been some wonderful play around these activities including lots of rocket building and space travel!
