I hope you have all had a wonderful and relaxing Easter with your families. It was great to welcome all the children back into school on Tuesday and what a first day they had exploring William Shakespeare courtesy of the Konflux Theatre Group! Each class participated in a workshop focusing on either William Shakespeare or one of his plays. Children in Donaldson class enjoyed activities about William the person and took part in exciting role-play activities, whilst in Dahl class they focused on the play A Midsummer Nights Dream – acting out the play, taking on the role of different characters and expressing themselves in different ways. Rowling close focused on the play Macbeth, with the children taking on the lead roles, acting out the play and immersing themselves in all the drama. A fantastic day was had by all and thank you to our host Louise who was fantastic and full of energy. Thursday saw Dahl class visit the Oriental Museum in Durham, where they explored the Ancient Egyptian civilisation, took part in an engaging and fun workshop as well as experiencing a mummy first hand. Around the Classrooms:

Donaldson: This week, we had a great morning session learning all about William Shakespeare and taking part in role play activities. We also watched snippets of Nomeo and Juliet to inspire us. In English, we have started to read our new class text: 'How to catch a star' and we have started to plan out a set of instructions on how to catch a star. In Maths we have been exploring numbers to 50 grouping 10s and 1s in Year 1 and in Reception we have been working on the composition of the numbers 9 and 10. In Science, we have compared the seasons of Winter and Spring.

Dahl: This week, in Maths, we have been mastering multiplying and dividing by 8 in Year 3 and in Year 2 multiplying by 2,5 and 10. In English, we have started to explore the character of Puck from A Midsummer Nights Dream as part of a piece of writing on character descriptions. In Science we have continued our unit on rocks and soils, and in History we began our project on the Ancient Egyptians and we all enjoyed a fantastic trip to the Oriental Museum in Durham.

Rowling: This week, we have been mastering multiplication and division in Year 4 and 5, whilst in Year 6 we have been converting measure. In English, we have started to explore the play Macbeth in preparation to write a set of instructions based on the characters the 3 witches. In Geography, we have located countries in South America as part of our project Around the World in 80 Days and in Spanish we have learnt vocabulary linked to where we live.

















Pre-School:

It has been a great start to the summer term with the children settling in well and getting back into the Pre-school daily routines. We have started a new topic, 'Amazing Dinosaurs', thinking about fossils and footprints and the many different dinosaurs there were! Our first super six book of the term is 'Stompysaurus' by Rachel Bright which has encouraged lots of thought and discussion about our feelings and how we manage them. The children have created drawings of happy, sad and even angry faces and we used pictures and books to think about how other people might



be feeling.
